

## **Biographical notes for Émile Vallée**

Born in Québec, Mr. Vallée has a master's in social sciences (industrial relations) from Université Laval. He has worked primarily in the union movement, working at the Canadian Labour Congress as a research assistant and later as executive assistant to the president, and working for the United Steelworkers of America as a researcher and then as a legislative adviser. Mr. Vallée has also worked at the Government Operations and Staff Relations Secretariat of the Privy Council Office and as director of special projects at the Canadian Labour Market and Productivity Centre.

Since 1995, he has been a political adviser with the Fédération des travailleurs et travailleuses du Québec.
